




**Directions:** Please board TRAM B from the city centre and get off at station –

#### **EXCURSION TO SAINT-EMILION**

Saint-Emilion, a medieval city located at the crossroads of Bordeaux, Saintonge and Perigord, is a UNESCO world heritage site. The history of this commune goes back to at least 35000 years ago. Vineyards make up more than 67% of the land area of the commune. Within the region there is a mix of medieval Romanesque religious architecture and vineyard "chateaux", built in 18th and 19th centuries.
